

Sewing Pattern — Lace set 5243

Recommendations on fabric: natural or synthetic silk.

You will also need: sateen, lingerie elastic tape 1cm. in width, cotton jersey and lace tape with scallops.

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Fabric:

1. Front with integrated string – 1 folded piece

Jersey:

2. Under front – 1 folded piece

Lace:

3. Yoke - 1 folded piece

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. With wrong sides together stitch the under front and outer front by hands blind stitch.
2. Stitch the elastic to the leg openings stretching it slightly (zigzag stitch). Fold the seam allowances to the wrong side and topstitch them with zigzag.
3. Stitch the centre seam of the yoke and press it open. Understitch the seam allowances. Stitch the yoke to the string. Press the seam allowance to the main piece and topstitch it.
