

Sewing Pattern — Embroidery Corset 2006

Recommendations on fabric: stiff satin

You will also need: separating zip, metallic/plastic bones, lace appliqué/embroidery, fusing, cords for loops

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

Seam allowances are NOT included by default and need to be added when laying out and cutting details if your pattern has single contour.

Seam allowances: 2 cm for middle back seam (to stitch the zipper). 1 cm for other seams

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Satin:

1. All corset pieces. Use also as lining.

Fusing:

1. All corset pieces.

Lace/trimming: sew to ready front parts and bead by hands.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Set metal/plastic bones which are 2 cm shorter than seam length (to make sewing more comfortable) in bodice seams.
2. The zipper is in back middle seam.
3. Fastener: on the collar back, 2 small buttons and cord loops.
