

Sewing Pattern — UNIFORM SHIRT 6095

NB! 0.8 cm seam allowances are already in patterns.

Recommendations on fabric: mixed fabric.

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

(On the pattern pieces, “beam” means straight of grain. Lay out your pieces accordingly. Some pieces will be cut on the fold. This is noted on the pattern piece. Mark all notches and other design features such as darts, pleats etc. from the pattern onto your fabric.)

Main fabric:

1. Back part – 1 folded piece
2. Back yoke – 1 piece
3. Front part – 2 pieces
4. Front sleeve – 2 pieces
5. Back sleeve – 2 pieces
6. Stand-up collar – 2 folded pieces
7. Inner collar fall – 1 folded piece
8. Outer collar fall – 1 folded piece
9. Pocket – 2 pieces
10. Pocket placket – 2 pieces
11. Pocket facing – 2 pieces
12. Flap – 4 pieces
13. Loop epaulette – 4 pieces
14. Sleeve placket – 2 pieces
15. Cuff – 4 pieces
16. Hem facing – 1 folded piece

APPEARANCE:

Uniform shirt for men, with buttoned center closure and with yoke. Front parts: two upper buttoned pockets. Set-in two-seamed sleeves with buttoned cuffs. Turn-down collar with stand-up detail; loop epaulettes are on shoulders. Garment hem with wide facing is gathered with elastic braid at sides.
