

Sewing Pattern — White coat 6092

Recommendations on fabric: cotton sheeting, bleached diagonal cloth

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

Seam allowances are NOT included by default and need to be added when laying out and cutting details if your pattern has single contour.

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



CUTTING:

Main fabric:

1. Half-belt – 2 pieces
2. Back part – 2 pieces
3. Lower pocket – 2 pieces
4. Upper pocket – 1 piece
5. Front part – 2 pieces
6. Blind closure – 1 piece
7. Stand-up collar – 2 folded pieces
8. Sleeve – 2 pieces

APPEARANCE:

Straight whites with 6 button blind closure and stand-up collar. Back vent; waistline: half belt can be regulated with buttons. Long set-in sleeve. Front parts: two lower patch pocket and one upper patch pocket.
