

Sewing Pattern — Baby bonnet 7142

Recommendations on fabric: light-weight slow to medium stretch knit fabric.

You will also need: decorative tape, bias tape.

If the pattern has a double line around it, the seam allowances are included.

Note: By default, seam allowances are NOT included (single line) and will need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam allowance: all seams – 0.7 cm; outer and lower edges – 0 cm.

Attention! First of all, please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must match up with corresponding pieces.



CUTTING:

The word, “beam” used on some patterns means “straight of grain”. Some pieces will be cut on the fold, this is noted on the pattern piece. Mark all notches and other design features such as darts, pleats etc. from the pattern onto your fabric.

Advice: Bonnet is for 0-6 months babies. For light-weight bonnets all seam allowances are 0.5 cm and serged to right side; decorative stitches are made on warmed bonnets.

Advice: Girl bonnets can be decorated with lace, bows and ribbons.

Fabric:

1. Side part - cut 2
2. Central part — cut 1

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Lay tape onto long edges of central part so that inner edge of the tape matches edge of the detail and topstitch.
2. Sew side parts to central part. Lay tape onto outer edge of bonnet and topstitch at 0.2 – 0.3 cm from the edge, easing in the bonnet. Pipe with bias tape outer edge of bonnet together with tape.
3. Pipe lower edge of bonnet with bias tape, leaving long tails for ties.
