

## Sewing Pattern — Vest with stand-up collar 4091

Recommendations on fabric: costume fabrics of natural or mixed fibers, contrast fabrics

You will also need: fusing; 2 buttons; lining

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam allowances: all seams – 1cm

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



### **CUTTING:**

#### Fabric:

1. Central back part - 2 details
2. Side back part - 2 details
3. Side front part - 2 details
4. Upper front part - 2 details
5. Central front part - 2 details
6. Buttonstand - 2 pieces
7. Lapel - 4 pieces
8. Stand-up collar - 2 pieces

#### Fabric:

1. Front inset - 2 pieces

#### Lining:

1. Central back part - 2 details    use patterns as for main details
2. Side back part - 2 details    use patterns as for main details
3. Side front part - 2 details
4. Central front part - 2 details

#### Fusing:

1. Buttonstand - 2 pieces
2. Lapel - 2 pieces

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Apply fusing to details.
2. Stitch relief cuts of back part, press allowances to the center. Sew middle cut of back part, press allowances to the left.
3. Sew the top front part to the side part, press allowances upwards and topstitch at 0.5 cm off the seam. Sew relief cuts of front part, press allowances to the center and topstitch at 0.5 cm off the seam.
4. Sew front inset to the front part, cutting allowance in the corner. Press allowances to the main part.
5. Stitch and press shoulder and side cuts.
6. Fold lapels right sides together and overstretch ledge and external cut. Slash allowances, turn the lapels out on the right side, straighten and press. Fold details of stand-up part of collar right sides together and overstretch external cut and sides. Slash allowances, turn stand-up collar right side out, straighten and press.
7. Apply the lapels on the central front part and topstitch to neckline cut. Sew a stand-up collar in the neckline.
8. Stitch cuts on lining details, leaving a slit for further turnout in the left side seam. Sew buttonstands to the lining.
9. Put buttonstand with lining onto right side of garment right side down, pin and overstretch stand, front part neckline, back part neckline and bottom edge. Overstretch from front part's side. Topstitch seam allowance on the buttonstand. Put the stitch on 0.2 cm off the seam. Turn the garment right side out. Overstretch armholes twice over. Sew the slit.
