

## Sewing Pattern — Large-collar jacket 5700

Recommendations on fabric: faux sheepskin.

You will also need: lather braid; 1 separable zipper; 2 zippers for sleeves

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam allowance: 1.5 cm for all seams, 0 cm for hem/sleeve hems/collar fall

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



### **CUTTING:**

Faux fur:

1. Upper back part – 2 pieces
2. Lower back part – 1 piece
3. Front yoke – 2 pieces
4. Middle front part – 2 pieces
5. Lower front part – 2 pieces
6. Upper sleeve – 2 pieces
7. Lower sleeve – 2 pieces
8. Back collar – 1 piece
9. Front collar – 1 piece

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Stitch middle back edges. Stitch lower back part to upper back part.
2. Stitch front yoke to middle front part. Stitch lower front part to middle front part.
3. Stitch shoulder edges.
4. Stitch collar's shoulder edges. Stitch the collar into the neckline.

5. Separate the zipper, fold braids' upper corners under. Lay the zipper on front part/collar right sides together; zipper teeth align with marked seams (zipper braid is on the allowance), then tack. Fold leather braid's short edges into wrong side, pin it to front part right sides together, then stitch catching zipper braids. Fold the zipper into wrong side, fold long edge under and topstitch it at 0.7 cm from front edging and along braid edge.

6. Stitch side edges.

7. Stitch upper/lower sleeves together. Stitch sleeve seam to the mark. Fold slit allowances into wrong side, lay the zipper under them, fold braids' ends and topstitch. Stitch sleeves into armholes as marked.
