

## Sewing Pattern — Set/Top 5252

Recommendations on fabric: light silk or cotton.

You will also need: embroider cambric; lace tape 1cm. in width; buttons.

If the pattern has double contour the seam allowances are included.

If the pattern has single contour, the seam allowances are NOT included and need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Attention! First of all please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need. Don't forget to count pair parts and symmetrical parts.

When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches, they must coincide.



### **CUTTING:**

#### Fabric:

1. Centre back – 1 folded piece
2. Side back – 2 pieces
3. Side front – 2 pieces
4. Centre front – 2 pieces
5. Upper front – 2 pieces

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Stitch the centre and side front pieces. Gather the top pieces of the front between the marks and stitch them to the lower front pieces.
2. Stitch back curved edges. Stitch the side/shoulder seams.
3. Fold the front self facings to the wrong side and press them.
4. Neaten the neckline, hem and the armholes. Press the allowances to the wrong side and topstitch them. Stitch the lace tape to these seams.
5. Make buttonholes in the right front piece. Attach the buttons to the left piece.
